*Trained in masonry by the Compagnons du Devoir and the Tour de France, Olivier Scherrer discovered building with earth when he volunteered in Mali to put in place a program to build schools, dispensaries and maternity wards between 1983 and 1985.*

*Parallel to obtaining a specialisation in earth architecture (CEA Terre at the Grenoble School of Architecture), in 1985 he co-founded the ACROTERRE association (Association des Constructeurs pour la Réhabilitation et l'Optimisation de la Terre) with which he took part in numerous development projects in Africa, Asia and Latin America.*

*Between 1989 and 1993, he was involved in the creation and management of a training center for Afghan refugees in Peshawar, Pakistan, and in a program to support reconstruction in Afghanistan, in partnership with German cooperation.*

*Beyond the technical, economic and organisational aspects, he is passionate about the human and social dimension of projects (Master's degree in Social Sciences, University of Lyon II, obtained in 1996).*

*Back in France in 2000, after 3 years in Colombia devoted to the implementation of a major social housing program, self-built by the inhabitants of a shantytown shantytown (mostly people displaced by violence), he created the company Ecoterre, which was transformed into a SCOP (a cooperative) in 2009.*

*Between 2000 and 2017, he alternated between managing the SCOP, construction sites in France, and consultancy missions abroad (Mali, Guinea, Burkina, Ivory Coast, Nepal, Colombia, Brazil, Haiti, etc.).*

*In 2018, following cyclone Irma, alongside the ANCB (Association Nationale des Compagnons Bâisseurs) he committed himself to the reconstruction of Saint Martin and set up a vast project to help rebuild the rooves of underprivileged people.*

*Since June 2019, Olivier Scherrer has resumed his activities as an independent consultant and is available to put his skills at the disposal of any interesting and motivating project.*
